#### If I am pursuing my LCSW can you still supervise me?

 Yes, but only for half of your hours. You will need to find another LCSW to supervise the other half

#### How will I get clients?

- If you are currently working at an agency/practice where you are seeing clients, but have no one to supervise you, I can supervise your work with those individuals
- If you do not have your own clients, I will assist you in acquiring clients

## How much do you charge for supervision?

- \$65/1hr session
- \$120 if meeting 2x a month (bi-weekly)
- \$230 if meeting weekly every month

#### How frequent/long will we need to meet?

• This depends on how many hours you need towards your license. Typically, we will meet weekly for 1hr individual supervision. Group supervision is also available.
